

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, District of Epping Forest) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic & Clearway) (No.1) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order:

1. To temporarily close the various lengths of road in the District of Epping Forest as specified:

Sewalds Hall Road, North Weald Bassett	From its junction with Hastingwood Road to a point approximately 233 metres south/east	No diversion available for this closure

Old House Lane, Roydon	From its junction with B181 Epping Road to a point approximately 458 metres east.	No diversion available for this closure
Epping Lane, Theydon Mount/Stapleford Tawney	From its junction with A113 London Road to its junction with Mount Road, a distance of approximately 1340 metres.	Epping Lane, B172 Abridge Road, A113 Ongar Road/London Road and reverse.
A121 Goldings Hill, Loughton	From its junction with B172 Jacks Hill to its junction with Millsmead Way, a distance of approximately 2120 metres.	Northbound: A121 Church Hill/High Road, A104 High Road Southbound, A1199 High Road, A104 High Road Woodford Green/high Road/Epping New Road. Southbound: A104 Epping New Road, A121 High Road/Church Hill.
B172 Coppice Row/Jacks Hill, Theydon Bois/Loughton Town/Waltham Abbey	From its junction with A121 Goldings Hill to its junction with Piercing Hill, a distance of approximately 2353 metres.	Piercing Hill, Theydon Road, B1393 High Road/Epping Road and reverse.
B181 Epping Road, Roydon	From its junction with B1133 Water Lane to its junction with Common Road, a distance of approximately 374 metres.	Common Road, Nazeing Common, Waltham Road, B194 Holyfield Road/Crooked Mile, Crooked Mile, Sewardstone Road, A121 Dowding Way/Honey Lane/Woodridden Hill, B1393 Epping Road/High Road/High Street/Palmers Hill/Thornwood Road/High Road Thornwood/London Road, A414 London Road, A1169 Southern Way, Water Lane and reverse
B181 Epping Road, Roydon/Epping Upland	From its junction with Epping Long Green to a point approximately 749 metres south.	B181 Epping Road, B1133 Water Lane, A1169 Southern Way, A414 London Road, B1393 London Road/High Road,



		Thornwood/Thornwood Road/Palmers Hill, B181 Lindsey Street/Epping Road and reverse.
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2. A temporary 'No Stopping' restriction will be introduced on both sides of carriageway on the above lengths of roads for the duration of the closure to facilitate the works. Signs will be installed indicating when the No Stopping restriction will be in force.

The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (permitted parking area and special parking area) (Consolidation) Order 2016 will be temporarily amended to include the temporary 'No Stopping at Any Time' restriction and suspend any existing parking and waiting restrictions on the above lengths of roads only. All other restrictions and exemptions contained in the aforementioned Order and Amendments to that Order shall remain in force

The works being undertaken will take place within an 18 month period from 6th February 2017, exact dates will be specified on <http://roadworks.org/>. The roads will be closed to facilitate each phase and then re-opened to the public. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and emergency services. Diversion routes will be signed at each location and residents will be informed of the dates of each phase via letter / leaflet drop and advanced warning signs on the road.

Phase one

Pre-surface patching works. These works comprise filling any surface defects and raising / replacing worn iron works (manhole covers and gully's) as well as removal of cat's eyes if present.

Phase Two

Surface dressing. The process entails spraying the road with bitumen and covering it with granite chippings, after which the road is then rolled, which along with the action of the traffic, embeds the chippings into the surface. The road will be swept within 48 hours and after 7 days. The bitumen part of the surface dressing as well as securing the chippings to the existing surface will seal the old road surface, thus preventing the ingress of water which causes deterioration of the road surface and will improve skid resistance.

Phase Three

- a) Reinstatement of white lines if required. Reinstatement of any road markings.
- b) Reinstatement of any road studs.

The Order will come into effect on 6th February 2017 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
