**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017
FOOTPATH 73 NAZEING**

Footpath 73 Nazeing

The above order, made on 24 February 2017, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert as shown on the Order Map the entire length of Footpath 73 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Map commencing from where it connects to Footpath 5 heading in an east, north easterly direction as a cross-field path for a total distance of approximately 238 metres to cross a field boundary then continue in a north easterly direction as a cross-field path for approximately 60 metres to where it connects with Footpath 28, to an alternative route 2 meters in width shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map commencing where it connects with Footpath 69 being north of the field boundary as a field edge path in a generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 266 metres to where it continues as a field edge path in first an easterly then generally northerly direction around a pond and headland for approximately 77 metres to where it connects with Footpath 28.

A copy of the Orders and the Order maps have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Chelmsford Public Library, Market Road CM1 1QH during normal working hours. Copies are available on request from the Chelmsford Library at a charge.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Robert Lee, Definitive Map Service, Essex County Council, Seax House, 2nd Floor, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford CM1 1QH no later than 04 May 2017. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Order. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
